

REGION TWO GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

The Region Two Cooperative Board recognizes its responsibility to set goals for the efficient operation of Region Two. In discharging this responsibility, the Cooperative Board will strive to ensure that the resources of Region Two are directed toward meeting the educational needs of each eligible student.

The responsibility of Region Two School of Applied Technology shall be to provide programs of education and training in trade, industrial, technical and service occupations to students in secondary schools and to provide and maintain facilities, sufficient staff and materials that will make it possible for students to attain entry level skills in the career of their choice.

In addition, learning a skill can reinforce or discourage a student's interest in a particular field. Students with CTE training are better prepared to become responsible, productive and contributing members of the community.

The Cooperative Board will evaluate the process used to meet these goals and adopt appropriate policies designed to facilitate continued accomplishment.
