ADMISSION OF ADULTS IN DAYTIME PROGRAMS

The following provision shall apply to the eligibility of adult students entering Region Two School of Applied Technology.

- A. General Right - A person entitled to receive free public secondary education, or seeking to attend full-time or part-time courses where offered, either free or subject to tuition.

- B. Special Qualifications - Region Two shall determine, by admission standards which apply to all students, whether an applicant is qualified to benefit from a technical education program and whether Region Two can accommodate the applicant.

- C. Admission Standards - Students who have graduated from a secondary school, or qualified persons who have left school prior to graduation may be enrolled in technical programs at Region Two School of Applied Technology provided:
 - 1. The student completes an application and submits it to the Region Two central office;

 - 2. The student can demonstrate competency in reading and math administered by the local Adult Ed program.

 - 3. The student can demonstrate good citizenship and represents no danger to the safety of students and staff and must pass a background check.

If a student meets the admission standards criteria and the following criteria, he/she may participate in daytime courses provided the following conditions are met:

- A. All secondary students will have first preference;
- B. The program desired has available space, not exceeding the per person per session limit in each technical trade program;
- C. The adult student agrees to abide by all policies and rules applicable to secondary students, understanding in advance that any adult student not abiding by Region Two policy may be expelled from Region Two; and
- D. Tuition will be commensurate with fees for adult education, as determined by the local adult education officials.
